

Terms & Conditions of Purchase

1. The Council's \$10 cloth nappy starter packs may only be purchased if your baby is aged 0 to 8 months, or if you are in the last trimester of pregnancy.
2. To purchase a pack, you must be the baby's parent or primary caregiver.
3. Only one cloth nappy starter pack may be purchased per child (this includes any pack purchased when the Council's Cloth Nappy Scheme was launched in 2010).
4. To purchase one of the Council's cloth nappy starter packs you must be a resident of the Waitaki District.
5. You will be required provide a photo ID, verification of address details, and the baby's birth certificate (or signed verification from a healthcare provider if in the last trimester of pregnancy) when making your purchase.
5. The Council will keep your contact details confidential. You may receive follow-up communication from a Waitaki District Council representative within 6 to 12 months of your cloth nappy purchase, and be asked a few questions about using cloth nappies.

Why cloth nappies?

Better for our tip (& our environment)

More than **600,000kgs** of disposable nappies and sanitary waste goes to the Oamaru landfill every year. That's a lot of space being wasted. There are some other things to think about too:

- If a baby wears disposables full time for 2 and a half years, the result is nearly 2 tonnes of wasted nappies.
- A disposable nappy dumped this month will stay in the tip for up to 550 years! That's how long they take to rot away.
- And while they're rotting, they keep leaking methane into the air, and the ETS will make us pay for that!
- It takes one cup of crude oil to make the plastic for each disposable nappy.
- More than a million trees are chopped down every year just to make the disposable nappies we use in New Zealand.

Better for your wallet

Yes, it's true! In the long term, modern cloth nappies are much cheaper to use.

Depending on different factors, such as your choice of products, and washing and drying methods, you can save a lot of money using modern cloth nappies. **Studies have shown that using cloth nappies for one child over two-and-a-half years can save you a lot of money - even up to \$5000 to \$6000.**

No hassle

Cloth nappies have come a long way in recent years. There are so many choices. And they look great too!

Modern cloth nappies are designed not to leak, and the fabrics they use make them easy to wash and dry.

Every one counts

If every new parent in Waitaki replaced one disposable with one cloth nappy a day, that would be at least 80,000 less disposables going into the landfill every year!

If you use cloth nappies just some of the time, it will make a difference to our landfill and our environment. If you are able to use them most of the time, then that's going to make a BIG difference.

Why a starter pack?

Getting to the bottom of the problem

For the sake of our landfill and the environment, we want to encourage all new parents to have a go at using cloth nappies.

Becoming a new parent can be stressful (and expensive), so the Council wanted to make getting started with cloth nappies as easy as possible. **That's why we're providing cloth nappy starter packs for new parents for just \$10. These packs would normally retail for around \$100!**

What's in the starter packs?

A great deal

Each cloth nappy starter pack contains 4 modern cloth nappies, from 4 different suppliers.

For just \$10, you get around \$100 worth of nappies.

The nappy pack also contains the Nappy Lady's helpful guide to modern cloth nappies, including information on how to wash them.

There is also some information about the nappies from the suppliers.

Each pack is suitable for boys or girls. 2 of the nappies in the pack will fit your baby from birth to potty. You can choose whether you want the other 2 nappies to be Newborn or Infant sized.

How to get one for yourself

It's as easy as...

Just filling out the application form on the right (and over the page) and bringing it into Council with your \$10 and the couple of bits and pieces mentioned at the top of the form.
