IMPORTANT INFORMATION

This competition is a team event. It will consist of a maximum of 10 teams competing across 6 different challenges.

Teams to consist of one adult (18+ years) and up to two children. At least one team member must reside in the Waitaki District. You do not need to be a Waitaki District Libraries member.

The competition will be held in the former Blind Foundation Hall, Steward Street, Ōamaru. (location to be confirmed)

Teams will need to be onsite no later than 9.45am on the morning of the competition

The competition will commence at 10.00am and finish at 3.45pm. There will be a 30 minute lunch break (lunch NOT provided) from 12.00pm-12.30pm, and a further short break at 2.00pm prior to the final build challenge.

NOTE: Due to the time commitment required for this competition it may not be suitable for younger children - please consider the 'staying power' of your child/children before submitting an application form.

Judging: Challenges will be graded/points allocated on all or some of the following: speed, technique, creativity, story, and aesthetics. Bonus points may be allocated at the judge's discretion. Judge's decision will be final.

Tiebreaker: in the event of two or more teams having equal points at the end of the 6 challenges, a tiebreaker challenge will be held.
