

What you need to know about our Kiwi-style camping facilities



Camping season

The Waitaki Lakes Camping season opens from the third Saturday of September until the first Sunday of May.

Camp fees

Camping fees apply to any vehicle, caravan or tent stationed at the camping round – irrespective of occupancy.

Season tickets only apply to the family unit named on the ticket butt, which shall comprise of no more than two adults and two children under fifteen.

Extra campers cost an extra \$15 each per season (under 5yrs free).

Camp fees:

- Season tickets: \$550
- Half season tickets: \$350
- Casual camping: \$25 per night for two adults and two children under 15
- Extra adults (over 15): \$10 per night
- Extra children: \$5 per night
- Extra children under 5 years: free

Boat ramps

Ramps are available at Parsons Rock, Loch Laird, Sailors Cutting, Falstone Creek and Boat Harbour camping grounds.

Ramp fees:

- Boat ramp daily ticket: \$7.50 per boat
- Boat Ramp Season ticket: \$75 per boat

Ramp fees apply to powerboats and yachts, not to rowers, kayaks, coracles.

Registration

- ▶ Fees must be paid prior to campsite set-up
- ► Tickets are non-refundable
- Tickets only apply to the family/individuals named on ticket
- ▶ Sites are not bookable. First in, first served
- Sites may not be cordoned off before camp set-up
- Sites can't be claimed on behalf of other campers

- **Step 3:** Once your payment is confirmed, your ticket will be posted to you.

Otematata on the Spot

sell Season CAMP and Season RAMP tickets. Cash, Eftpos or credit card at counter.

Camp registration kiosks

have casual/day envelope tickets available. Cash, or contact the camp supervisor for Eftpos* or internet banking details.

Note: Otematata Boat Harbour Season tickets are only available from Waitaki District Council or Camp Supervisor.

*Limited cell reception at Falstone Creek – pre purchase season tickets or cash only for casual camping.

Season ticket butts or envelope stubs MUST be displayed clearly at each camp site.
