Feedback on the Draft District Plan Review 2022.

- * Waitaki residents are not 'customers' of the council. We, as ratepayers, are employers; owners of the assets of the district, which are administered by council staff.
- * Increasing the current 4ha. land size for residential use to 20ha. is limiting to people who would like to own property larger than a lifestyle block of 1ha. Perhaps considerations might be given to proximity to the town boundary.
- * 'Climate change' has world-wide focus. Urban density plays a part in the changing weather patterns, yet there is a 'push' to increase this density. Tree-lined streets reduce the heat of rising summer temperatures but they are disappearing as more housing developments take over formerly-productive farmland. Open spaces; larger, not smaller, sections; native trees and shrubs will help combat this issue.
