Submission on the Draft Waitaki District Plan - Ngapara Holdings Trust

Natural Features and Landscapes Chapter and Schedule 7 - Outstanding Natural Features

1. This submission is made on behalf of Rodney Jones and Sajini-Jesudason-Jones as trustees of Ngapara Holdings Trust (**the Trust**) in relation to the zoning and activity statuses that apply to mineral extraction and the Waiareka Escarpment (**Escarpment**) in the Draft Waitaki District Plan (**Draft Plan**).

Waiareka Escarpment

- The Escarpment has been identified as an Outstanding Natural Feature (ONF) in the Draft Plan.
- 3. The Trust supports the zoning and activity statuses relating to the Escarpment in the Draft Plan.
- 4. The Trust supports quarrying and mining having a non-complying activity status in the Escarpment due to the ONF.
- 5. The Trust supports the removal of the Cement Policy Area equivalent or similar overlays that would allow quarrying or mineral extraction near the Escarpment in the Draft Plan.
- 6. The Trust supports in part the mapping of the ONF over the Escarpment. However, there is a 400m distance between the Escarpment and Weston-Ngapara Road which is not identified as an ONF. This area is relevant to the landscape feature because structures and/or activities in front of the Escarpment could adversely affect the landscape values associated with the Escarpment and therefore should have an ONF overlay.
- 7. In relation to the proposed provisions of the Draft Plan, the Trust requests that:
 - the rules and activity status framework in the Draft Plan, particularly relating to quarrying and mineral extraction near or on the Escarpment, are carried into the Proposed District Plan; and



- (b) the ONF overlay is extended to include the 400m distance between the Escarpment and Weston-Ngapara Road to protect the landscape values associated with the Escarpment.
