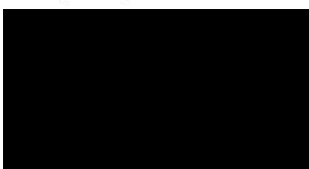

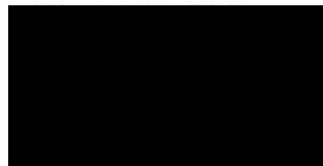

My main concern around the potential development of this land is around the infrastructure needed to support the extra vehicle movements once developed. I currently live on Avon street as a renter and will not always live here however I am confident Avon street in its current form would not be able to sustain the increased vehicle movements that will come about from the development. The road is not wide enough for two way traffic and through traffic travelling at excess speeds to get to the other end of the street will provide dangerous conditions for many of the driveways in Avon street with heavily restricted views while backing onto the road. If Avon street is used as an access point for this development and especially if it is used as the sole access point there will be a collision or collisions on the street.

I believe council should consult the public on exactly what caveat's would be in place should the development proceed as this piece of land is one of the most visible parts of Oamaru and potential options such as restrictions on colours and materials should be considered to make the houses blend in more with the surroundings to mitigate any potential eye sores that could come about without intervention.

I would encourage council to spend the time to fully consider any and all options at their disposal should the development proceed as it is more important than at any other subdivision in Oamaru that you get it right due to the fact the entire town will see this on a daily basis.

This land should be kept in either it's current state or partially developed into native bush or some type of vegetation that could potentially generate income through carbon credits.

Hi,

I do generally think it would be better suited as a reserve for ALL recreational users, but I worry that Council will not allocate the correct amount of energy into the upkeep of the facility. Other than the fantastic Oamaru Gardens, the reserves around Oamaru are often neglected.

There are examples of this now:

- Less than timely interaction with interest groups has lead to frustration and heightened division amongst user groups.
- The overall plan for Cape Wanbrow has seen little action.
- There is no control of people planting the natives in Cape Wanbrow, which leads to the fantastic views being lost forever - there should have been a plan (or just control) that leaves areas with views, along with areas of natives - there could have been both - opportunity lost!

For the above reason I do see that sale of the property is possibly a good thing to do. I am comfortable with it being a subdivision and have little worry of the impacts of the subdivision. Land stability is fine and ground erosion issues can be engineered to be of little issue also, likely helping with the issues of erosion on the bottom side of Test St. I would like to see multi use access through the Subdivision to the Lookout area

I do not agree with the stance taken of the Friends of Oamaru Harbour. Members of this organisation have a long history of abuse, unsubstantiated complaints of mountain bikers and sabotage of mountain bike tracks on Cape Wanbrow. I do not trust their intentions or their views. Care should be taken as these people have on more than one occasion erected tracks and carried out plantings on Council property without permission. I do not think they represent anyone but themselves.

I believe there is an opportunity for many of the ideas being bandied about to coexist. The land identified as Forrester heights is endowment land and as such is there to provide a return to the Council / community.

Using the Ground Lease concept of co-ownership:

1.0 Proposal:

- 1.1 Council retains ownership of the land and develops it for residential housing.
- 1.2 The sections then become leasehold.
- 1.3 Council builds the dwellings and sells them at market rate.
- 1.4 Limit the number of dwellings to 10 or 12 and scatter them within the defined area.
- 1.5 Plan into the space between sections native planting areas with plant species that are low in height so as not to restrict views from the dwellings but will enhance the biodiversity of the area (birds, pollinators, insects etc) and provide walkways.

2.0 Benefit:

- 2.1 Council receives ongoing income for eternity from leasing the land to the dwelling owner/s
- 2.2 Council receives ongoing income from the Rates
- 2.3 Makes the housing affordable
- 2.4 As the developer, Council makes a profit from the sale of the dwelling.

3.0 The Mechanics:

- 3.1 Put covenants in place restricting dwelling height, design, colour, plant height etc. This is common in gated type communities for example and should not be a disadvantage to the development and sale of the sites.
- 3.2 Set the lease fee as a percentage of the land value only. This will still allow for the dwelling owner to make enhancements to the dwelling / property at a later date (within covenant restrictions) making it more attractive to buy for future owners.
- 3.3 Set the lease review period in line with the property valuation cycle. Charge the lease as a part of the Property Rates Bill.
- 3.4 Make the lease a perpetual lease which transfers automatically from one dwelling owner to the next when the dwelling is sold so there are no issues for any dwelling owner in the future when they want to sell the dwelling.
- 3.5 Prior to building, ballot the dwellings for ownership and use the successful applicants funds to build the dwelling based on progress payments ensuring all material and project management costs along with a margin are included in the buy price.

4.0 Outcome:

- 4.1 The area identified as Forrester Heights becomes a small residential area while retaining the characteristics of a native reserve.
- 4.2 Biodiversity within the area will be enhanced.
- 4.3 Council continues to get income from the land without reducing it's asset base and therefore retains equity to support future borrowings.
- 4.4 The development of the sites pays for itself through the lease process.
- 4.5 Once the development costs have been recouped, the ongoing income can be spent on other projects... perhaps speed up / assist the development of Cape Wanbrow into a full native reserve?

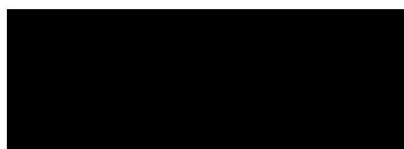

What kind of question is that! The Act passed in 2013 can simply be undone. To say it would be expensive and 'may not get passed' is quite disingenuous in my view.

To even consider selling for development such an iconic block of land, above a world-renowned penguin colony (endangered species), a beach inhabited by seals, a huge shag colony, the only suitable swimming beach in the town, in front of the lookout point which would further isolate it from the rest of Cape Wanbrow, in the middle of a climate crisis seems to me to be about as short-sighted as anything could possibly be!

You say 'some people think Forrester Heights is a reserve now' which implies that in the mind of the community it already IS public land. And to imply that it is either/or when it comes to more reserves in the North End is to create a false dichotomy in people's minds.

There is already an active volunteer group working on the reserve, and if your concern is cost of upkeep, it is relatively simple to give these volunteer groups some financial backing (trees, hard surfacing, etc) and leave them to supply the labour. You might care to look at Waiheke Island as an example of local initiatives to plant and maintain reserves and tracks - Friends of MacKenzie Reserve, Friends of Te Toki Reserve, Friends of Atawhai Whenua.... The latter reserve was envisioned and planted about 25 years ago by one far-sighted person and now covers many hectares, has fantastic walking tracks, wildlife, wetlands, etc and is maintained by volunteers. It has changed from steep, bare, erosion-prone farmland to a huge community asset.

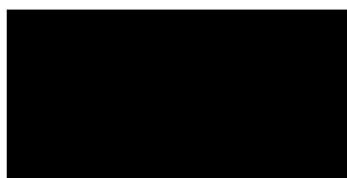

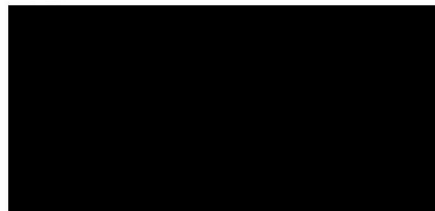

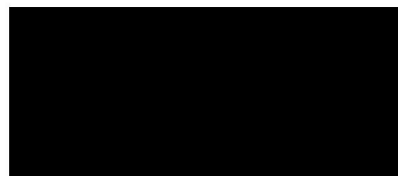

This was a very lengthy process and did involve an act of parliament - only to find that the engineering and ground work involved to build on the said land, at the time meant, it was not economically viable?

Further more, let's look to the future - not only is this piece of land, as a reserve, a fantastic asset for local residence but living close to the area, I can tell you that many tourists come up to the Lookout to enjoy the amazing unobstructed views over the historic harbour and town. If the subdivision was to go ahead, from the grassy area directly above the land often used by families and groups for picnics and photo opportunities, they would be looking over rooftops? Is this what the Council are proposing? Friends of the Harbour have done an incredible job of developing the path, seating and planting of natives on the land at no cost to Council - on the other hand the council have allowed areas of the Cape Wanbrow track to be planted in Pine which have grown to a height where the amazing views of the harbour and town which were originally visible are now obstructed from large portions of the walking track. This also makes the track less safe for single (particularly female) users and particularly over the winter months. 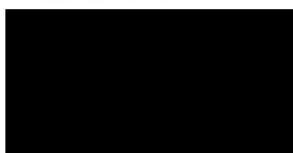

My concern is that a truly big-picture understanding of the physical nature and consequent visual amenity of our local landform and our stewardship responsibilities pertaining to it has been largely overlooked in favour of limited vision, and prosaic and mundane commercial concerns.

Oamaru uniquely sits in the motherly embrace of the western hills and the southern Cape, an L-shaped protecting form. The western arm long ago lost much of its original rolling and treed softness to boxy development but its shadowed bulk still defines the town and has controlled its linear development.

But the Forrester Heights land is currently contiguous with the largely unscathed faces of the Cape (though one might rail against the aesthetic rape of the Cape by our forebears for similar pragmatic purposes!). It is also coterminous with the line of the western edge of the harbour, the whole making a composition which is greater than the sum of its parts.

The Cape and the land in question together with the harbour foreground are continuous and homogeneous in aesthetic impact. Together they form a powerful and unified backdrop to the harbour and town, even with the current patchy appearance of Forrester Heights. The north facing aspect means the area is bathed in light and sun (which of course makes it desirable for housing!). But the proposed temporal commercial objectives of council and future developers both represent a failure to "see" and a risk of destroying this essential unity forever.

Regarding housing development, and speaking as a retired Architect, my opinion is that the blithe hopes of council that design and planning rules will mitigate inevitable ugliness and the loss of landform unity on this site, is naive. Certainly current planning standards will result in massive cuts and retaining walls, competing one-off tacky-tacky (but up-market) boxes with narrow slot side yards, views from the harbour to the undersides of stilt-supported floors, and a patchwork façade palette with acreages of glass. Unlikely to produce an integrated visual symphony for harbour-side viewers! Softening with trees might help but they also tend to block out those views which house owners paid through the nose for! Architects employing a mutually agreed unified vision might produce something more acceptable but there are few visually integrated hillside developments that I can think of apart from mono-palette high density examples (think Italian or Greek hill towns) or low density environment-sensitive examples (e.g. Sea Ranch California).

To me the decision council makes here has an unmistakable ethical component. Not every bit of land with the whiff of a dollar drifting over it has to be seen as an exploitable opportunity for commercial purposes, no matter the embedded legal constructs currently at play or the laudable desire to advance other critical developments. Maori concepts regarding Papatuanuku have much to teach us in this regard with respect to our connection to the land. For those with ears to hear, certain tracts of land such as the Cape and the Heights together embody values which might be considered as spiritual. They transcend monetary values and private interests in favour of a perhaps intangible and ongoing higher public good. In my view therefore and whether it is "useful" in terms of Reserve or not, the land should be treated with respect, perhaps planted out so that the Cape and Forrester Heights and Harbour read as a single unified entity strengthening, not weakening the living landscape painting which is being conceived here.
