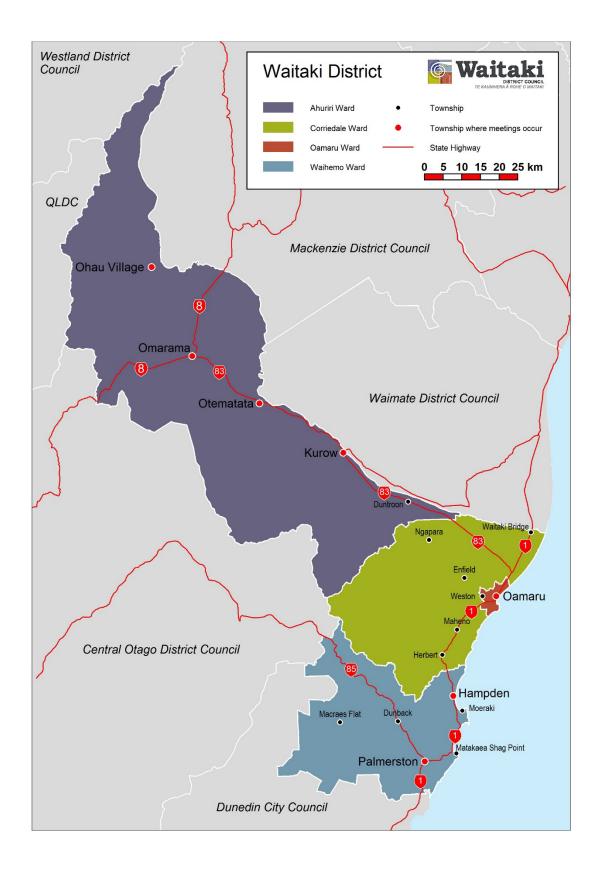

3 CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

3.1 PUBLIC MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 24 MAY 2022

That the Executive Committee confirms the Public Minutes of the Executive Committee Meeting held on 24 May 2022, as circulated, as a true and correct record of that meeting.

The Committee briefly discussed whether they felt it was necessary to go into public excluded to discuss and approve the Council Controlled Organisations' Directorship Review Timetable in public excluded. When there was no objection to discussing it in public, the Chair ruled that it would be treated as a public document.

5.1 COUNCIL CONTROLLED ORGANISATIONS' (CCO) DIRECTORSHIP REVIEW 2022 TIMETABLE PE

The report, as circulated, sought the Committee's approval of the timetable for the 2022 Review of Council Controlled Organisations' (CCO) Directorships.

The Chair shared his concerns that the timetable was stretched out too far and would restrict the Committee's time and ability to facilitate the directorship review process. He acknowledged that the timetable had been designed to accommodate the cross-over with the pre-and post-elections period, but suggested changes be made, as set out below.

The Chair suggested that, however the Executive Committee is constituted after the elections, there is agreement now to ask at least two of the three retiring Committee members to return and continue to contribute to the CCO Directorship review process, as their experience would be helpful. In response to questions, it was clarified that those returning members would be participating in an advisory capacity only (ie they would not be appointed under the Local Government Act), as ex officio members with no voting rights. This was agreed.

Timetable changes were proposed as follows:

- Advertisements would be placed in mid-September (16-17)
- · Expressions of interest would close on 7 October
- The shortlisting workshop would take place on 19 October
- The rest of the process would be brought forward from there (with the Governance Advisor to revise the timetable accordingly).

The Chair noted that the decisions on CCO directorship appointments could be made by the Executive Committee a couple of weeks earlier than the original schedule suggested. They could still go to the final Council Meeting of the year (tentatively scheduled for 6 December 2022), or an Additional Council Meeting could tentatively be scheduled for 29 November 2022 instead.

The Committee briefly discussed the directorships that were to be renewed in this 2022 round; and which Chairs / Deputy Chairs / other Directors would be invited to have discussions with the Committee on 6 September to help inform the Committee's decision on which positions needed to be advertised.

The Governance Advisor was asked to revise the timetable in accordance with the changes proposed, and to commence implementation of the process in consultation with the Mayor and Human Resources Advisor as stated.
