Conditions

1. Permission to erect the cattlestop(s) is a temporary concession and may be revoked at Council's sole discretion.
2. All costs relevant to the supply, erection, maintenance and removal of the cattlestop(s) will be borne by the applicant.
3. The cattlestop(s) shall not be less than 5 metres in width and shall be of a type approved by Council.
4. I/We shall clear and keep clear all noxious weeds the road reserve from the cattlestop(s) onwards.
5. No trees, hedges or other vegetation shall be planted in the road reserve.
6. Failure to comply with the above conditions may be cause for Council to revoke its permission and to order the immediate removal of the cattlestop(s), at the cost of the applicant.
7. A sign stating "Public Road" to be installed and maintained at the cattlestop.

Further Conditions contained in **Local Government Act 1974, Section 344 Gates and cattle stops across roads**, and the **Gates and Cattle Stops Order 1955 - (SR 1955/67)** also apply. It is the applicant's responsibility to adhere to these statutes.
