- 1. the total number of artworks owned The Forrester Gallery has 2,186 works accessioned into the collection.
- **2.** the total value of artworks owned The total value of these works is \$4,037,835.00
- 3. the number of those artworks:
 - a. on public display (public does not include council buildings, unless that building is explicitly a gallery or museum)

No works from the Forrester Gallery Collection are on display as of 3 November 2021. We do have a collection of 62 Vignettes on display from the Waitaki Archives, who are a sibling organisation. Please note that the number of works on display and where they are located varies throughout the year as exhibition change and loans are made to support exhibitions at other venues.

- b. displayed in council buildings (excluding galleries and museums) Two works on display in the Opera House
- c. in storage 2,184 works in storage
- 4. A percentage breakdown of the origins of the collection, for example: 30% commissioned 20% purchased 50% gifted.

Break down of the origin: Purchased – 13%; Gifted – 59%; North Otago Museum – 4%; No data – 24%

5. the value and description of the most valuable item. The most valuable work in our collection is *North Otago* by Colin McCahon. This is an acrylic work on board of the North Otago Landscape. It was valued at \$450,000 in July 2010.
