The proposed temporary filming activity is required to have the following resource consent under the Resource Management Act 1991:

• Rule 10.1.1.2 Temporary activities (marginal non-compliance with relevant assessment matter 10.1.2.3 (c) The impact on the road network and traffic safety in the vicinity of the site))

The proposed filming activity is set to take place for approximately 2-3 weeks over the period late August to late October 2018 at the location identified in Map 1 attached. The activity involves an initial set-up time (approximately 15 days) involving around 6 people, and actual filming (over a two day period on 12 and 13 October 2018) involving approximately 100 people. The application notes that actual dates for filming activities may differ due to weather. During scene set-up time, there will be approximately 6-8 vehicle movements per day, and 2-3 trucks (10 tonne or less). During shoot days there will be approximately 40-60 truck vehicle movements over the two days, and it is estimated there will be approximately 200 car/ute vehicle movements per day typically arriving on location between 5am and 7am, and departing between 5pm and 7pm. Effluent and waste disposal and power will be catered for over the entire period at the location.

Pursuant to Section 87BB(2)(b) of the Resource Management Act 1991, Council has waived the resource consent requirements for the proposed activity for the following reasons:

- i. The Waitaki District Plan does not specifically provide for filming on a temporary basis as a temporary activity, however does provide provisions for temporary activities and relevant assessment matters.
- ii. The proposed filming activity will take place inside an existing building there will be no exterior filming.
- iii. Access to the site will be via a gravelled road off Lake Ohau Road.
- iv. Traffic movements over and above the expected baseline for a Rural zoned property will be limited to the periods 5am to 7am, and 5pm to 7pm on the two scheduled filming days.
- v. A Traffic Management Plan will be prepared and submitted to Council.

- vi. A Traffic Management Company has been hired throughout the entire filming time to manage any adverse traffic effects to and from the site.
- vii. All waste will be managed and removed off-site.
- viii. Power will be supplied to the location.

This certificate relates only to the proposal as detailed under the landuse consent reference 201.2018.1146. This certificate will lapse 5 years after the date of this notice unless the activity permitted by the notice is given effect to.
