DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Upper Waitaki Young Farmers Club for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 31 Gordon Street Kurow 9435 known as “**Kurow Community Hall**”.

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - **Saturday 17 February 2024 from 5.00pm to 12.00 midnight**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied. Bottles of water will be available as specified in the application.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times. A one course meal consisting of meat, salads, breads in addition to food platters provided throughout the event is specified in the application.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages (Heineken Light) must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages such as juices and soft drinks must be available for sale and supply on the premises throughout the period of the special licence.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premise. A courtesy van must be available as specified in the application.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.
