DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Papakaio School for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 641 Georgetown-Pukeuri Road, Papakaio known as "**Willow Park**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - **Saturday 17 February 2024 from 12.00 midday to 7.00pm.**
2. **MANAGEMENT:** A Manager shall be present on the premises and on duty for the duration of this event. Kathryn Emma Swan (66/CERT/233/2017) is named as Duty Manager.
3. **FOOD:** Food will be provided in the form of multiple food stalls and BBQ. Food must be available throughout the entire duration of the event. If food is no longer available, alcohol sales must cease.
4. **NON AND LOW ALCOHOL DRINKS:** An adequate supply of non-alcoholic and low-alcoholic beverages including juices, soft drinks, tea, coffee, and low-alcohol beer must be readily available.
5. **WATER:** Drinking water must be freely available to customers from the Bar and water stations.

Signage advertising the location of this free water shall be displayed.
6. **DESIGNATED AREAS:** The Special Licence area will be undesignated.
7. **SIGNAGE:** Signage is required to be displayed stating that alcohol will not be served to any intoxicated person, alcohol will not be served to minors under the age of 18 years and ID is

required. The statutory provisions preventing sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons must be enforced for the duration of the event.

8. **TRANSPORT:** A phone shall be available for the ordering of alternative transport as may be required. Signage advising of this assistance shall be displayed as well as the telephone number of local taxi firms.
9. **DISPLAY OF LICENCE:** This licence shall be displayed in a prominent public position at the principal entrance to the premises and at each point of alcohol sales.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 641 Georgetown-Pukeuri Road, Papakaio are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **26 January 2024**
