DECISION - ON PAPERS

This is an application by Wholesale Seeds Limited for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 2A Ettrick Street Oamaru North Oamaru 9400 known as "A & P Showgrounds".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - Saturday 24 February 2024 from 11.00am to 4.00pm
- (b) Bottles of drinking water must be freely available on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption on the premises. The application specified BBQ foods (meat, salads, bread, etc.)
- c) Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises. Steinlager Light is specified in the application.
- d) Soft drinks and water must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. Staff must assist with safe transport options, either by arranging a taxi or making a cell phone available to call a sober transport option.

The name and phone numbers of the local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.

- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Alcohol may be sold in the following types of containers only: Plastic or cans.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) A maximum of 2 alcoholic drinks may be sold to one patron at a time.
- (b) This licence does not excuse the applicant from obtaining where necessary a Building Consent in respect of tents or marquees.
- (c) An exemption from having a Certified Manager on duty is granted subject to Geoff Mavor being responsible for the sale of alcohol activities for the duration of the event.
