DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by The New Zealand Whisky Co Limited for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Ettrick Street Oamaru 9400 known as "**A & P Showgrounds**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Saturday 24 February 2024 from 9.00am to 4.00pm**
- (b) Drinking water must be freely available on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) The licensed area will be designated as supervised.
- c) Water must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times.
- d) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. Staff must assist with safe transport options, either by arranging a taxi or making a cell phone available to call a sober transport option.
The name and phone numbers of the local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.
- e) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- f) Alcohol may be sold in the following types of containers only: Bottles. All bottles must be wrapped in closed paper bags and only available for collection on exiting the showgrounds.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) This licence does not excuse the applicant from obtaining where necessary a Building Consent in respect of tents or marquees.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 11 Wansbeck Street Oamaru 9400 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on 21 February 2024.
