**DECISION – ON PAPERS**

This is an application by Musical Theatre Oamaru Incorporated for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Tyne Street Oamaru 9400 known as "**Scottish Hall**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

**Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions**

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Friday 22/03/2024 and Saturday 23/03/2024 from 6.00pm to 11.30pm.**
- (b) Drinking water must be freely available from the bar at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied.

**Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions**

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption throughout the period of the special licence. Sues Cheese Rolls is stated as the provider with Cheese rolls, Soup and Bacon Butties available. If at any time food is no longer available, alcohol sales must cease.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages (2.5%) must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as specified in the application. The name and phone number of the local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Alcohol may be sold in the following types of containers only: Glass, plastic, bottles, and cans.
- h) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

**The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:**

- (a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at Tyne Street Oamaru 9400 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **27 February 2024**.
