**DECISION – ON PAPERS**

This is an application by Waihemo Collie Club for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 98 McLay Road, Dunback known as "**Waihemo Collie Club**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

**Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions**

- (a) Alcohol may only be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Wednesday 3 April 2024, Thursday 4 April 2024 - 12.00 midday to 10.00pm**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises from the bar and kitchen area.

**Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions**

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied. The application specifies a full hot lunch followed by BBQ dinner in addition to sandwiches, baking, and snacks.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages (Speights Mid-Ale) must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages (tea, coffee, soft drinks, and water) must be available throughout the event.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. A free phone and courtesy vehicle are specified in the application.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signage regarding no sales to prohibited persons must be clearly displayed.

- g) The nominated manager must be present or available throughout the entire period of operation that pertain to the hours of the Special Alcohol Licence, to ensure the requirement of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed. Nominated manager: Sandra Annette Chapman.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.
- (b) The organisers must be proactive in promoting non-drink driving.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 98 McLay Road, Dunback are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **1 March 2024**.
