DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by St Kevin's College for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Taward Street Oamaru North Oamaru 9400 known as "**Centennial Park**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Sunday 17 March from 12.00 midday to 6.00pm**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises as specified in the application.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- Food must be available for consumption on the premises as specified in the application.
- Low-alcohol beverages (1.5-2.5%) must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
- Non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
- The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as specified in the application. The name and phone number of the local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.
- A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.
- A maximum of 2 alcoholic drinks may be sold to one patron at a time.
- This licence does not excuse the applicant from obtaining where necessary a Building Consent in respect of tents or marquees.
- Steps must be taken to ensure no BYO alcohol is bought onto the site.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at Taward Street Oamaru North Oamaru 9400 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **6 March 2024**.
