DECISION - ON PAPERS

This is an application by Oamaru Collie Club for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 1250 Waianakarua Road Kakanui 9495 known as "Oamaru Collie Club".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - Friday 19 April 2024 and Saturday 20 April 2024 11.00am to 11.30pm on both days.
- (b) Drinking water must be freely available from the bar and kitchen at all times.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be always available for consumption on the premises when alcohol is being sold or supplied. Morning and afternoon teas, lunches comprising of either Blue Cod, chips and salad or cold meat, potatoes and salad options are specified in the application. Savouries, sandwiches, cakes and biscuits are also specified in the application as being provided to supplement meals. If required a BBQ dinner should be available for the evening.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale or supply on the premises.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale or supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. Alternative transport signage must be displayed and sober drivers and cell phones available.

- f) A copy of this licence, together with signage showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

(a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 1250 Waianakarua Road Kakanui 9495 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **15 March 2024**.
