DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by The Nourish Project Limited for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 37 Airedale Road Airedale-Weston 9492 known as “**Rockvale Gardens**”.

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Sunday 24 March 2024 from 12.00 midday to 5.00pm**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises as specified in the application.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied. Burgers, hot chips, salads, and wok made meals are specified in the application.
- Low-alcohol beverages (less than 2.5%ABV) such as Scotts Explorer must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- Non-alcoholic beverages such as soft drinks juices and zero percent beer, wine and cider must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as specified in the application. The name and phone number of the local taxi company must be clearly displayed.
- A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- Alcohol may be sold in the following types of containers only: plastic cups or cans.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.
