DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Kurow Rugby Club for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 21-29 Manse Road Kurow 9435 known as "**Kurow Rugby Football Club**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Sunday 6 August 2023 from 11.00am to 4.00pm**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available in the licensed area and from the bar.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption on the premises throughout the entire period of the event.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages (2.5%) must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale or supply of alcohol.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale or supply of alcohol.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. A courtesy vehicle must be provided as specified in the application.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied, and consumed within the licensed area.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) This licence does not excuse the applicant from obtaining where necessary a Building Consent in respect of tents or marquees.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 21-29 Manse Road Kurow 9435 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **17 July 2023**.
