**DECISION – ON PAPERS**

This is an application by Five Forks Young Farmers Club for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 11 Paradise Gully Road Ngapara 9491 known as “**Union Rugby Football Club**”.

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

**Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions**

(a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

- **Thursday 17 July 2025 from 4.00pm to 10.00pm**
- **Sunday 20 July 2025 from 11.00am to 6.00pm.**

(b) Drinking water must be freely available on the premises from a water station on the bar.

**Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions**

- a) Eden -Maree Cooney is appointed Manager and must be on site for the duration of the event.
- b) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- c) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied. Hot chips, steak sandwiches/burgers, bacon butties, sausages in bread and savouries are specified in the application.
- d) Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied. Export 2.5% is specified in the application
- e) Non-alcoholic beverages such soft drinks and 0% beer must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.

- f) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as specified in the application. The name and phone numbers of local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.
- g) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- h) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 11 Paradise Gully Road Ngapara 9491 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **11 July 2025**.
