DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Oamaru Jockey Club Incorporated for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at main North Road, Oamaru known as "**Oamaru Racecourse**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- Friday 15 August 2025 - 11.00am to 6.00pm
 - Sunday 17 August 2025 - 11.00am to 6.00pm
 - Sunday 14 June 2026 - 11.00am to 6.00pm
 - Sunday 19 July 2026 - 11.00am to 6.00pm
- (b) Drinking water must be freely available at each end of the bar on the premises as specified in the application.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold/supplied. Pies, savouries, sandwiches, chips, and soup are stated in the application.
- c) At least one low-alcohol beverage must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times alcohol is being provided and/or sold. (Speights Mid Ale is specified in the application).
- d) Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied.

- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as specified in the application. The name and phone number of local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Only the following kind or kinds of alcohol may be sold on the premises: Beer and wine.
- h) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at Main North Road, Oamaru are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on 17 July 2025.
