DECISION - ON PAPERS

This is an application by Kurow Rugby Club for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Gordon Street, Kurow known as "Kurow Community Hall".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - Saturday 19 August 2023 from 6.30pm to 12.30pm the following day
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises in small bottles available from the Supper room and the Bar as specified in the application.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold and/or supplied. "Make Your Own Buns" and savouries and spring rolls have been specified in the application.
- Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises. Heineken Light is specified in the application.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages (soft drinks, orange juice, tea, coffee, and water) must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. The application specifies courtesy vehicles will be provided and advertised.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Members of the public must be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances:
- h) Entry is restricted to ticket holders only
- i) Only the following kind or kinds of alcohol may be sold or delivered on or from the premises: Wine, Beer and Cider, RTD's
- j) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the Kurow Community Hall.

Section 147 (2) - Restricted and supervised areas
The following area is designated as a restricted area: The entire Kurow Community Hall area.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

(a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at Gordon Street, Kurow are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on 31 July 2023.
