DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Oamaru Harness Club for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Pukeuri-Hilderthorpe Road, Oamaru known as "**Oamaru Racecourse**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

(a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:

- Sunday 20 August 2023 - 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm
- Sunday 17 September 2023 - 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm
- Sunday 15 October 2023 - 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm
- Thursday 9 November 2023 - 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm
- Wednesday 13 December 2023 - 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm
- Wednesday 24 January 2024 - 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm
- Sunday 4 February 2024 - 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm
- Wednesday 6 March 2024 - 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm
- Sunday 24 March 2024 - 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm

(b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises from bottled water and the tap in the kitchen.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) A reasonable selection of food at reasonable prices must be available for consumption on the premises. Pies, chips, sandwiches are specified in the application.

- c) Low-alcohol beer must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises. Zero percent beer, orange juice and water are specified in the application.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as specified in the application. The name and phone number of the local taxi company must be clearly displayed.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Only the following kind or kinds of alcohol may be sold on the premises: Beer, wine, RTD's and Cider.
- h) Alcohol may be sold in the following types of containers only: glass, bottles.
- i) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at Pukeuri-Hilderthorpe Road, Oamaru are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **14 August 2023**.
