DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Hospitality on Thames Limited for an on-licence in respect of premises situated at 84 Thames Street Oamaru 9400 known as "Fat Sally's Pub & Restaurant".

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a Restaurant.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

A further report has been received from the Licensing Inspector noting an error regarding the hours sought under the original application. At the time of the interview with the applicant hours were discussed and the applicant changed the hours sought to Monday to Sunday 8:00am to 1.30am the following day. These hours are within the default hours set by the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the changed hours on the papers.

The change in hours are approved as being Monday to Sunday 8:00am to 1:30am the following day. All other conditions remain as per the original licence issued.

The licence may issue immediately and expire on 15 March 2024 as per the original licence, unless renewed.
