DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by St Kevin's College for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Taward Street Oamaru North Oamaru 9400 known as "**St Kevins College**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Saturday 9 September 2023 – 3.00pm to 11.30pm.
- (b) Drinking water will be provided freely on all tables.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) A certificate holding Manager shall be present on the premises and shall not consume alcohol for the duration of this event. John McGeown is the manager named in the application.
- c) Canapes, dinner and dessert must be provided, and food should be available for consumption throughout the period of the Special Licence.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages such as water and soda must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as specified in the application. The name and phone numbers of local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Members of the public must be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances:
- h) Entry is restricted to invited guests only.
- i) Only the following kind or kinds of alcohol may be sold or supplied on the premises: –Wine.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.
