DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Otematata District Club Incorporated for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 8 Tasman Road Otematata 9412 known as “**Otematata District Club**”.

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Saturday 23 September 2023 and Sunday 24 September 2023
from 4.00pm to 1.00am the following day**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises from the bar as specified in the application. Water must be freely available throughout the period of the special licence.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) The nominated manager must be present throughout the entire period of operation that pertain to the hours of the Special Alcohol Licence, to ensure the requirement of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed. Nominated manager: Samantha Trotter. The manager may not consume alcohol while carrying out the duties of Duty Manager for the duration of the event.
- c) Food from either of the two menus provided must be available for consumption throughout the period of the special licence.
- d) At least one low-alcohol beverage must be available for sale and supply on the premises. Heineken Light is specified in the application. A lower alcohol wine is also specified.

- e) Non-alcoholic beverages such as soft drinks, juices ginger beer and lemon, lime and bitters must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
- f) A courtesy van must be provided, and the licensee must take steps to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises.
- g) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- h) Members of the public must be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances:
Entry is restricted to invited guests only.
- i) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

Section 147 (2) - Restricted and supervised areas

The following area is designated as a supervised: Courtyard, Main Bar and Pool Room. The Gaming Room is designated as a restricted area. The Dining Room is undesignated.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.
- (b) The premises are to be vacated within 30 minutes of the time at which the premises are required to be closed for the sale of alcohol.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 8 Tasman Road Otematata 9412 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **1 September 2023**.
