DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Howden Holdings Limited for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 10 Tyne Street, Oamaru known as "**North Otago Scottish Hall**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may only be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Friday 17 November 2022 from 7.30pm to 11.30pm**
- (b) Drinking water must be freely available on the premises from either water jugs on tables or the bar.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises is open for the sale or supply of alcohol. The application states a full buffet meal is supplied.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages must be available at all times the premises is open for the sale or supply of premises.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. The local taxis numbers must be prominently displayed.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Entry is restricted to ticket holders only.
- h) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied, and consumed within the plan of the premises as submitted with the applications.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents or guests at nearby accommodation providers.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 10 Tyne Street, Oamaru are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on 29 September 2023.
