DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Oamaru Victorian Heritage Celebrations for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Severn Street Oamaru 9400 known as “**Early Settlers Hall**”.

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may only be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Friday 17 November 2022 from 10.00am to 1.00pm**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises as specified in the application.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption on the premises. Cakes, biscuits and savouries are specified in the application.
- c) At least one low-alcohol beverage must be available on the premises. (An alcohol content of 2.5% is specified as being low-alcohol.)
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages such as water, tea and/or coffee must be available for sale and supply on the premises throughout the Special Licence.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. Local taxi numbers must be prominently displayed.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Entry is restricted to ticket holders only
- h) Only the following kind of alcohol may be supplied on the premises: Madera

- i) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

Section 147 (2) - Restricted and supervised areas

The entire premises will be undesignated.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 1 Severn Street Oamaru 9400 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **6 November 2023**.
