DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by The Penguin Entertainers Club for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 10 Harbour Street, Oamaru 9400 known as "**Penguin Club Incorporated**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Sunday 19 November 2023 from 10.00am to 9.00pm – Victorian Fete**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises from jugs of water and glasses on the bar as specified in the application.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied.
- Low-alcohol beer (Steinlager Light and Heineken Light) must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application throughout the events.
- Non-alcoholic beer and juices must be available for sale and supply on the premises throughout the events.
- The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as specified in the application. The name and phone number of local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.
- A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at Whole Waitaki District Street Waitaki District 9400 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **10 November 2023**.
