## **DECISION - ON PAPERS**

This is an application by Omarama Rodeo Club for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at Ben Omar Road Omarama 9412 known as "Omarama Rodeo Club".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

## Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may only be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
  - Thursday 28 December 2023 from 11.00am to 7.00pm
- (b) Drinking water must be freely available on the bar at the premises.

## Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) A certified Manager (Lynette Gillian Duncan) shall be present on the premises and on duty whilst the bar is open for the sale or supply of alcohol.
- c) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold. If food vendors leave the site, alcohol sales must cease.
- d) Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
- e) Non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises.
- f) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. A courtesy coach as specified in the application must be available and promoted.
- g) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- h) Only the following kind or kinds of alcohol may be sold or delivered on or from the premises: Beer, cider, RTD's.
- i) Alcohol may be sold in the following types of containers only: Plastic.
- j) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied, and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.
- (b) The Alcohol Management Plan, as provided with the application and the undertakings within, are to be read as conditions of the licence and must be adhered to.
- (c) This licence does not excuse the applicant from obtaining where necessary a Building Consent in respect of tents or marquees.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at Ben Omar Road Omarama 9412 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on 16 November 2023.
