**DECISION – ON PAPERS**

This is an application by Oamaru Intermediate School for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 24 Pembroke Street Oamaru North Oamaru 9400 known as "Oamaru Intermediate School".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Friday 1 December 2023 from 6.00pm to 11.00pm**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises as specified in the application.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food platters, sandwiches and savouries, must be available for consumption on the premises throughout the period of the special licence as specified in the application.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages (2.5%) must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages such as soft drinks, tea, coffee, must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as specified in the application. The name and phone number of the local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.
- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Members of the public must be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances: Entry is restricted to table holders only.
- h) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the hall area.
