DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by Kurow Jockey Club Incorporated for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 21-29 Manse Road Kurow 9435 known as "**Kurow Racecourse**".

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Saturday 30 December 2023 – 11.30am to 5.30pm**
- (b) Drinking water will be freely available on the premises as specified in the application.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The nominated manager (Jamie Hughes) must be present throughout the entire period of operation that pertain to the hours of the Special Alcohol Licence, to ensure the requirements of the Act and conditions of the licence are observed.
- b) The nominated manager may not consume alcohol for the duration of the event.
- c) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
A comprehensive range and substantial amount of food must be available for all in attendance. A minimum of at least three types of food such as Paninis, sandwiches, wedges, pies, pizzas, filled rolls or salads must be available for the entire duration of the licence. Food must be available for consumption at all times alcohol is being sold and/or supplied. If food is no longer available, alcohol sales must cease immediately.
Food traders must be sited in an area close to the licensed areas. Low-alcohol beverages (Speights Mid and Steinlager Light) must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times alcohol is available for sale and/or supply. Soft drinks and zero alcohol beer are specified in the application.

- e) The applicant shall provide adequate security to ensure that no intoxicated persons are permitted entry to the venue.
- f) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. A courtesy van must be provided as specified in the application.
- g) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- h) Alcohol must only be sold, supplied and consumed within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.

Section 147 (2) - Restricted and supervised areas

The following area is designated as a supervised area: Members Bar and Public Bar. The Public Bar area shall be clearly defined by way of adequate fencing.

The applicant shall provide adequate security to ensure that no persons under the age of 18 are permitted entry to the Members Bar and Public Bar area without supervision of a parent or guardian.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- (a) This licence does not excuse the applicant from obtaining where necessary a Building Consent in respect of tents or marquees.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 21-29 Manse Road Kurow 9435 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **16 November 2023**.
