DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by The Penguin Entertainers Club for renewal of a club-licence in respect of premises situated at 10 Harbour Street South Hill Oamaru 9400 known as **“Penguin Entertainers Club”**.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act. We renew the licence on the existing terms and conditions.

The Licensed Premises:

In terms of s.105 (e) of the Act the premises, situated at 10 Harbour Street South Hill Oamaru 9400 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **5 December 2023**.

The licence may issue immediately and expire on 21 October 2026 that being three years from the most recent date of expiry, unless again renewed.
