	<p>The rule states that poultry farming cannot occur within 100m of the property boundary. In the case of free range production this means that chickens cannot access outdoor range areas within 100m of the boundary even if their indoor enclosure is more than 100m from the boundary without requiring a consent. This is an unreasonable request that requires a costly consent process to approve for. If it is not approved in a consent it will lead to a lot of unproductive land on free range farms. Chickens have a fraction of the potential disturbance of of animals such as sheep or bulls which are able to access areas right up to boundaries.</p> <p>A reasonable request would be that in the case of free range farming chickens require their hen house to be more than 100m from the boundary but can roam in their outdoor areas up to the boundary</p> <p>I am happy to be contacted to discuss further</p>
