## The Harbour Berth holder agrees to:

- To pay berth fees of \$1,000.00. Initial payment is to be received by Council along with completed application.
- Maintain the security of the Wharf at all times. Keep the key safe and not identify
  the key or keys in any way that could be detrimental to Wharf security.
- The berth holder is not to lend the key or keys issued to any other party
- · Remove all rubbish, refuse and contaminants from the Wharf
- Comply with all maritime rules and obligations to protect the marine environment from harmful substances.
- Comply with all maritime rules and obligations to keep to 5 knots or less within 200m of the shore or 50m from another person or vessel.

Council accepts no liability for any action whatsoever arising from this arrangement or the use of or associated with the berth. Any breach of these conditions will be sufficient grounds for Council to cancel this agreement.

By signing this agreement you agree that contact information may be shared with other agencies.

The granting by Council of this right to berth a vessel is granted specifically to the Harbour Berth Holder and is solely at Council's pleasure and may be revoked or terminated at any time by Council. Should this right to berth be terminated by Council then the Harbour Berth holder remains liable for all outstanding fees, expenses etc, and any cost incurred by Council in terminating this arrangement e.g. removing a vessel from the Harbour.
