Waitaki District Licensing Committee 2017 Annual Report For The Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority

1. Overview Of DLC Workload

There are five members of the DLC, they are Cr P Garvan (Chair), Cr J Hopkins (Deputy Chair), Mr K Scott (Commissioner), Dr J Sutherland and Cr H Perkins. Mr Scott heads the "B" committee.

The Chairman attended a webinar and three members attending training held in Timaru.

Two committee meetings have been held.

There have been no hearings.

2. DLC Initiatives

The DLC have used an informal meeting to identify issues.

3. Local Alcohol Policy

Council officers have been working with various agencies to access statistical information. A workshop will be held with Council to confirm progress and next steps which is likely to include facilitated sessions to gather qualitative information. Once collated we will be in a position to progress an Alcohol Strategy which may include regulatory, non-regulatory or a mix of options. We expect to complete this work during the 17/18 financial year.

4. Legislation

Section 35 deals with complementary sales. Cheese and wine are commonly regarded as complementary but cheese makers are excluded as their principal business is the sale of food. Was this ever the intention of parliament to exclude a cheese manufacturer from selling wine?

5. Other Matters

- There were no objections from the public to off or on licence applications.
- Many premises across the district are closing earlier than licensed hours reflecting reduced demand.
