

Water main renewals – South Hill area

Dear Resident

Council contractors will be renewing water mains in the South Hill area over the next few years.

This will result in several improvements to the service we can provide you – including water pressure and quality - and will significantly reduce the risk of supply failure in the future.

This work will be completed in stages. The attached map shows areas that will be affected during each stage of work.

Stage 1 is due to start in February and will be completed by the end of 2017.

How this work may affect you

If you live in or around the area where work will be carried out, there may be some disruption to your water supply and vehicle access for short periods of time while work is underway.

Our contractors will only be working on 100 metre stretches of road at any one time and will do everything they can to minimise disruption.

If you have any special requirements for water or access to your property – for example, you operate a business in the area or have health issues - we will ensure special measures are put in place for you.

Road maintenance

The water mains renewal work will cause some surface damage to roads in the area. These roads will be fully repaired once the renewal work has been completed.

Communication

About two weeks before work is due to start in any particular area, we will contact affected residents and businesses by letter or phone.

If you live or run a business in the affected area and have requirements for vehicle access or water supply during a specified work period, you can contact us prior to work commencing to discuss ways we can assist you.

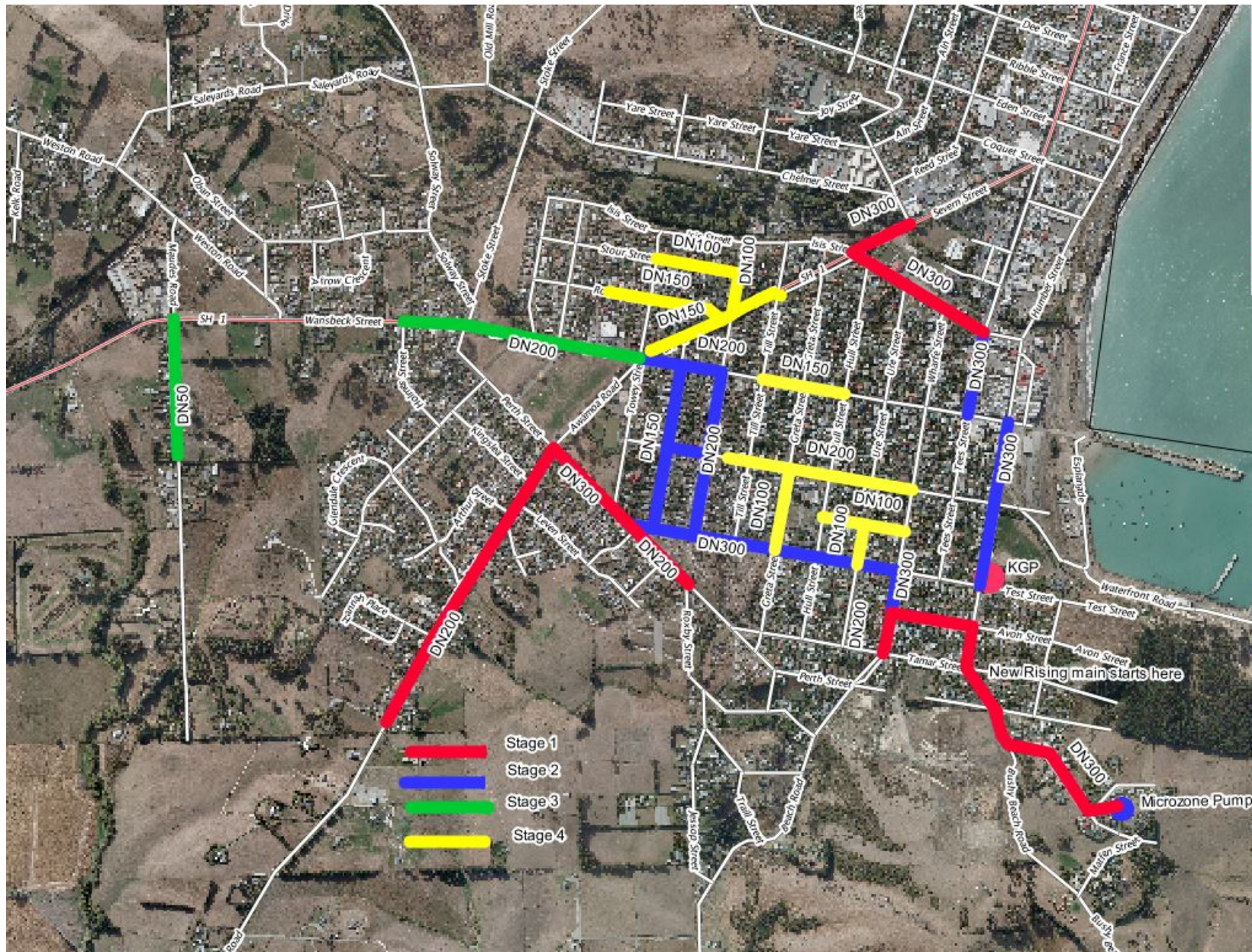
